On August 10, 2011, Command Sgt. Maj. Carlton Handy assumed the responsibilities as command sergeant major of the U.S. Army Evaluation Center, Aberdeen Proving Ground, Md. He also advises and initiates recommendations to the Commander and Staff pertaining to the local Noncommissioned Officer Support Channel.

Handy entered the U.S. Army in 1982 and received Basic and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, S.C. He has an associate's degree in general studies from Central Texas College and a bachelor's degree in liberal arts from Excelsior College.
