



Ronald E. Orosz

Command Sgt. Maj. Ronald E. Orosz enlisted in the United States Army in March 1985 and attended Basic Training and One Station Unit Training at Fort Benning, Ga., graduating as a Military Occupational Specialty Infantryman (MOS 11B).

Orosz served in every duty position from M60 Machinegun Ammo Bearer to Command Sergeant Major. He served in 1st Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, 5th Battalion, Ranger Training Brigade; Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 75th Ranger Regiment, 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment; CSM for 2-6th Infantry Battalion (Mechanized), 2nd Brigade, 1st Armored Division; CSM for 3rd Brigade Combat Team (Light), 1st Infantry Division, and the CSM for the 20th Support Command (CBRNE).

His overseas service includes Operation Just Cause (Squad Leader), Panama; Operation Enduring Freedom (Regimental Operations NCO and First Sergeant), Afghanistan; Operation Iraqi Freedom (First Sergeant), Iraq; Operation Iraqi Freedom 05-07 (CSM); and Operation Enduring Freedom VIII (CSM).

His military schools include Airborne School; Ranger School; Static Line Jumpmaster; Military Freefall Course; Military Freefall Jumpmaster Course; Pathfinder Course; and all phases of the Noncommissioned Officer Education System. Some of his awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit; Bronze Star Medal with V device; Bronze Star Medal (three oak leaf clusters); Meritorious Service Medal (two OLCs); Army Commendation Medal (seven OLCs); Army Achievement Medal (three OLCs); Good Conduct Medal (12 knots); Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal with Bronze Arrowhead; Joint Meritorious Unit Award; Valorous Unit Award; Army Superior Unit Award; Meritorious Unit Commendation; Expert Infantryman's Badge; Combat Infantryman's Badge (2nd award); and Master Parachutist Badge with Bronze Star.
