

Aberdeen Test Center COVID-19 Visitor Guidance

<p>All Visitors</p>	<p>ATC COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedure:</p> <p>All visiting test participants/observers must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have ATC approval for onsite visitors to witness or participate in a test • Be able to answer daily medical screening questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Are you feeling sick today? ○ Have you had close contact with anyone with confirmed COVID-19? ○ Have you travelled outside the local area? • Wear a face covering at all times while on APG. • Minimize sharing of workspaces and equipment. <p>Everyone at all times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear face coverings/masks when working within 6 ft of other personnel and in all buildings. • Monitor your health and inform your Supervisor/Escort of any changes • Practice hygiene standards and keep areas clean
<p>International Travelers</p>	<p>Department of the Army: If arriving from a CDC Travel Health Notice Level 2 or above location, complete a 14-day quarantine (per FRAGO 18 to HQDA EXORD 210-20 and DoD Force Health Protection Supplement 14).</p> <p>CDC: All air passengers coming to the United States, including U.S. Citizens, are required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • get tested no more than 3 days before you travel by air into the United States and show your negative result to the airline before you board your flight, • or show documentation of recovery from COVID-19 (proof of a recent positive viral test and a letter from your healthcare provider or a public health official stating that you were cleared to travel). <p><i>References:</i> Force Health Protection Guidance Supplement 14 Requirement for Proof of Negative COVID-19 Test or Recovery from COVID-19 for All Air Passengers Arriving in the United States CDC</p>
<p>Additional Recommendations (non-mandatory)</p>	<p>Maryland Department of Health: When practicable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediately get a COVID-19 test upon arrival in Maryland or within 72 hours before travel to Maryland. • Asymptomatic individuals shall self-quarantine while awaiting test results. • Get a second COVID-19 test within 72 hours of arrival in Maryland because of the novel coronavirus' incubation period. <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Travel to the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the States of Delaware and West Virginia by Marylanders is exempt from this recommendation.</i> ▪ <i>Employee commuters who leave/enter the state on a regular basis and have work-based COVID-19 screening procedures do not need to quarantine.</i> ▪ <i>Employees who occasionally travel to or from Maryland for work-related purposes shall, to the extent reasonably practicable, comply with the quarantine and testing requirements above.</i> <p><i>Reference:</i> Maryland Department of Health Order, 2020-12-17-01</p>
