The top four resources for the workforce to get emergency or critical information about DPG are:

1. Call 435-831-2000. This number is updated by DES with information at 0400 each day.
2. Register your phone and other user devices on AtHoc to receive important alerts about issues or changes to operations at Dugway.
3. Monitor your email.
4. Contact your supervisor.
